

Caradon Cooperative Educational Trust School Council Meeting

Aimee D and Harry R-H met with other council members from Coads Green, Delaware and Upton Cross this week at Coads Green Primary School. The CCET School Councils have decided to apply for the PADL (Promoting Active Democracy Loudly) Gold Award. PADL is a set of standards for primary school councils which guide and measure effective student voice, representation and leadership within schools. In order to gain a PADL award, trained young assessors interview staff and school council members using formulated questions appropriate to the level of award the school are applying for.

The children discussed what needs to be achieved for this award and will set a plan in motion in each school. They will meet again in December to share ideas and to see how far each school's plans have progressed.
