School starts at 08.55am and finishes at 3.15pm. It is vitally important that you get your child to school on time. This promotes good timekeeping and routine, and your child will be able to start the day with their friends. Children that are late disrupt the classes and will miss the settling in period during registration. Some children may find it embarrassing to join the class on their own.

#### **Absence**

If your child is ill, please ensure that you inform the school before 09.30. If no explanation is received, you will received a text requesting that you contact the school. Reasons for absence will not be accepted from a sibling. Any unexplained absence will be recorded as unauthorised. If absence is due to medical reasons, please provide the school with a copy of your child's appointment. If possible, please make routine medical/dental appointments outside of school time.


#### Absence Requests

We recognise that it is often expensive to take a holiday during school breaks and that is why some parents may ask for term-time leave for their child. However, it is important that parents carefully consider the implications of taking their child out of school during term time

Research suggests that children who are taken out of school may never catch up on the course work they have missed. This may affect test results and can be particularly harmful if the child is studying for final year examinations.

Children who struggle with English or Mathematics may also find it even harder to cope when they return to school, while younger children may find it difficult to renew friendships with their classmates.

If you are considering absence from school for any reason (not illness), Absence Request forms are available from the school office or can be downloaded from the website.


