Puffin Class Wheal Martyn Clay Works visit - Wednesday 26th March 2025

We are pleased to announce that an exciting educational visit for all of Puffin Class to Wheal Martyn Clay Works has been organised to enrich the children's learning about 'Cornwall' and their learning in both History and Geography. The day will include a Guided Tour of the Victorian Clay Works.

Puffin Class will also take part in a workshop 'Mapping our Heritage'. They will discover how clay has changed the local area over the last 250 years. They will also explore time capsules of key historical figures and create a 3D map to show how the industry has shaped our local area.
