This year, parents and carers are invited into classes at 2.45pm on the 6 of March so the children can share their love of reading during the day. The children will have chosen books, poems etc. to share with you, and you are welcome to bring in your own favourite childhood book to share with your child or children.

Following the success of our approach to World Book Day last year, this year again, we will be providing an opportunity for the whole school to make a World Book Day hat in school linked to the book: 'Wild Child – A Journey Through Nature' by Dara McAnulty. This hat can then be worn on World Book Day as part of the celebrations.

Children are welcome to wear their uniform on the day or come to school dressed as their favourite book character, but dressing up is not a requirement as we appreciate the financial struggles for many of our families at this time.
