Class focus of the week—Doves

In Doves, our art unit for this half-term is all about mixing colours. We have learnt about the three primary colours- red, yellow and blue - and how to mix them to make the secondary colours - green, orange and purple. We even mixed all three primary colours and made brown!

This week we looked at Jasper Johns acrylic on canvas painting called Numbers in Colour and created our own Numbers paintings in the same style. First we used the three primary colours in a thick way - impasto, next we mixed the primary colours to make the secondary colours and added them to our paintings. Here are the amazing results:
