This week Wrens have been spending time learning about shadows and when we see them. We discovered what causes them and then went into the playground and drew around each other's shadows. After that we made our own shadow puppets and used a torch to make a shadow on the white paper.







Doves class

Doves have completed their windmills for our Design and Technology unit on structures. The mouse is ready to move into his new windmill home! Over the last few weeks we have discussed the different parts of the windmill and assembled the structure, turbine and axle:

Supporting structure: the part that makes the windmill stand up.

Turbine or sails: the pieces that move in the wind. Axle: the point from which the turbine/sails move.

This week the final part was to evaluate their windmills based on our original design criteria and to amend the windmills if needed:

Design criteria:

- My windmill should stand up on its own
- My windmill should be decorated for its owner (the mouse)
- My windmill should have three parts
- My windmill should blow in the wind.

We placed our squirrel feeder carefully in our outdoor area and left food for the squirrel who visits our school on a regular basis. We then made tree faces out of clay and other natural materials.
