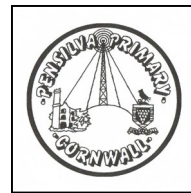

Wrens class

This week Year Ones were set a challenge by Miss King to work out which of the pots had something in them and which were empty. We had to use our senses.
